

Cleaning & Maintenance Guide

Care instructions across our glass range — most need no special treatment

General Cleaning

The great majority of CSU glass — clear float, Low-E, toughened, laminated, tinted and solar control — is cleaned exactly the same way: a standard glass cleaner and a soft cloth or squeegee. No special products are needed for any of these. Low-E and solar control coatings sit on an internal cavity face, fully protected inside the sealed unit, so both outward faces clean as normal.

Product-Specific Notes

Product	Care Notes
Mirror glass	Standard glass cleaner and soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid letting fluid run down behind the frame or pool at the bottom edge — moisture reaching the silvered backing is the main cause of edge de-silvering.
Laminated glass	No special maintenance. Keep edges protected during transport and installation, since damaged edges exposed to moisture can affect the interlayer over time.
Self-cleaning glass	Needs 5-7 days of UV exposure and at least one rain shower to activate after installation. Does not remove mortar, paint or hard water marks — occasional manual cleaning may still be needed in sheltered locations.
Smart glass (PDLC)	Clean as standard glass with no abrasive products. Keep control wiring and connections protected from moisture at the frame junction.
Tinted / body-coloured glass	Cleaned the same way as clear float. The colour will not fade or wash out since it is not a surface treatment.
Integral blind units	The blind itself never needs cleaning — it is permanently sealed inside the cavity. Clean the glass faces as standard.
